

SPINSTER VILLAGE HOUSE INFORMATION

- 2 When the house is vacant we turn the thermostat up to 75F in summer, and down to 63F in winter.
- 3 You do not have to worry about bedding, towels, etc. The only thing we ask is, that before you leave you have it all washed. Beds do not have to be remade. Just leave the clean bedding on the foot of the bed. The washer and dryer are in the master bathroom.
- 4 Basic cooking ingredients are also there. Again, we just ask you to replace what you use i.e. paper products, Napkins, paper towels, toilet paper.
- 5 We have basic cable for the three TVs. The DVD/CD player works by pressing the television's input button to say "video 1". There are several places in the area where movies may be rented.
- 6 Please note that access to the sound side dock and the community pool/tennis courts requires use of the key.
- 7 The grill has a full tank of gas as of the beginning of the season. The ignitor is broken, so please use a long match or lighter. When finished, please be sure to turn off the gas at the tank as well as the knobs.
- 8 Beach towels are in the master bathroom.
- 9 We would ask that if the plants need to be watered, please do so.
- 10 There is one grocery market in Duck, Tommy's Market (We recommend the cookies and steaks!), along with a few convenience stores. There is a Food Lion and Seamark Foods in Kitty Hawk. There are also several additional stores in Kitty Hawk, including a Wal-Mart and Home Depot.
- 11 TO THE BEACH: Go straight across to East Bias. There are parking spots there. It says that a permit is required, but this is not the case. Please do not park on other people's yards or on the street.
- 12 Please be sure to dispose of all perishable foods prior to departure. Other items with longer shelf life can be left at your discretion.
- 13 Trash pickup is Monday and Thursday - Everything must be inside the trash can. They will not pick up items sitting next to the can. Make sure the can is next to the road and facing forward. (They are very picky).
- 14 All the "no's"; Fireworks are prohibited in Duck. Please don't smoke in the house. Please be mindful of the antiques.
- 15 And finally, please remember we do **not** have a maid coming in after you leave. We ask that you please take out the trash, vacuum, and wipe down all counters, etc so that the next visitors can have a pleasant experience as well. Please depart by NOON on Monday, as new visitors will arrive after you.
